Sample Course 2: Work-Process Oriented Development of Curricula

This course will respond to labour market needs. The capabilities of the participants' will be developed to carry out work-process analyses. The outcome of the work-process analyses will be used for developing a work-process based curriculum. This type of curriculum will form the backbone for generating Learn- and Work assignments for a needs oriented training. Related to the work-processes the curricula form a framework for shaping TVET and competence development.

It is important to include the social implications of work in relation to each specific cultural context.
