

# Quality in TVET Cooperation

## Sample Course 1: Quality assurance in cooperative Training and Apprenticeship

The course focusses on Quality assurance in dual trainings and apprenticeships, conducted in cooperation between TVET institutes and the private sector. It aims to enable the participants to develop high quality dual trainings by implementing structures, methods and processes, using good practice examples from different regions, countries and economic sectors. It follows up on the more general course “Linking TVET Institutes with the Private Sector” as an immersion into the course topic as one main area of cooperation.

**Content, elements, format and duration can be customised to the respective needs**

### Learning outcomes

On completion of the training, participants can

- describe the different main types of dual training and apprenticeships
- analyse existing dual training approaches
- name the different methods, tools and processes for quality development of dual training
- plan, prepare, conduct and evaluate dual trainings

### Contents

- Different areas and types of dual training and apprenticeship as cooperation between business sectors and TVET Institutions
- Good practice examples from different regions, countries, levels, sectors and sub sectors
- Quality development instruments, tools and methods
- Methods of evaluation and assessment of dual training quality control

- Face-to-face
- Virtual formats
- Blended learning

- At least 5 years of professional experience in TVET

If necessary, a 10 hrs initial training on ICT and e-learning can be provided.
