Occupational Safety and Health (OSH)

Sample Course 1: Basics of OSH

The course focusses on the basics of OSH. It aims to establish a general understanding of OSH by introducing the different components leading to a holistic OSH approach within an organization. The course enables the participants to analyze key areas of action at the development of working and health conditions. Furthermore, the participants are able to identify approaches in order to improve safety, health and well-being of the employees. The course is conceptualized as action-oriented format with active involvement of the participants and the application of best practice examples. It is to be regarded as introduction into OSH; immersions of special subjects are based on this course.

Content, elements, format and duration can be customised to the respective needs.

On completion of the training, participants can

- understand the different components of OSH with an organization and their linkages
- analyze potential fields of action at the development of safe and healthy working conditions
- develop strategic concepts to improve safety, health and well-being of the employees
