TVET plays a key role in implementing the vision of sustainable development (SD) on global as well as on national level. Participants will reflect on the overall concept of SD and the role that TVET could play in the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). In order to anchor TVET for SD in the respective national TVET system the participants will be coached to design and disseminate country-specific National Action Plans (NAPs).

- are able to explain the importance of NAPS for the strategic implementation of ESD / TVET for SD
- are able to draft a NAP (incl. vision/mission statement, fields of action, objectives, activities, indicators, milestones and responsibilities)
