- Designing, conducting, administrating and evaluating courses with digital media tools and applications
- Relevant ICT hardware
- Design and production of text-based media, presentations, images and video
- Online communication techniques
- Data security and copyright
- Relevant pedagogical and media concepts

Formats

Virtual format implemented with following main digital media (e-learning) elements:

- Lectures/presentations via video stream (live or on demand)
- Group and one-on-one video calls for mentoring and discussion

Text-based communication chat, group chat, e-mail and message boards (e.g. MS Teams channels)

The practical approach includes group and project work.
