Sample Course 1: Planning & Development of Course Programmes – Exploring Work Processes

In this course methods for identification of work-processes and work-process knowledge are focussed to identify work-process knowledge for course programmes and the design of course programmes. Methods for work process analyses and their application in practice will be introduced; the transfer of work-process knowledge in a course programme will be practiced.

Content, elements, format and duration can be customised to the respective needs.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the training, participants

- are able to identify work requirements
- have access to the reality of work and know methods to identify requirements
- explain the importance of work processes for competence development in TVET
- have the skills to “open up” work processes
- have the capabilities to explore work process knowledge relevant in TVET
- are able to plan programmes and courses following work-process requirements
- are able to identify different opportunities of the design of courses and programmes

- Design principles of courses and programmes
