Sample Course 4: Project Method - Practical Training in the Field of Carpentry

This training is based on a practical and methodological approach, where participants learn how to apply the action-oriented project method for the qualification of future professionals in the field of carpentry. A real project and corresponding teaching activities will be designed, implemented and evaluated.

Content, elements, format and duration can be customised to the respective needs.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the training, participants

- are able to explain approach of the project method
- have practised the application of the project method, using a complex real case
- are able to use selected working and instruction techniques
- are able to create a training concept, using the project method
- are able to conduct practical training based on the project method
- have developed an individual project

Contents

- Overview knowledge and principles of the project method
- Practical examples of the project method in wood working
- Practical training using project method and learning by customer's orders
- Health and safety at work
- Exercises on selected working techniques
- Exercises on selected instruction techniques

Formats

Face-to-face format implemented with following methods:

- Workshop/ seminar
- Practical training
- Action orientation
- Individual work/ self-learning
- Cooperative work
- Project method

The course can be supplemented with a company visit.
